

3. that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Minister of Tourism, Culture, and Sport, the Minister of Finance, the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the MPP for Hornepayne, the Ontario Library Association, the Federation of Ontario Public Libraries, and to the Council of the Township of Hornepayne for its endorsement.”
